The new, approved, composition roofing materials were discussed.

Need to look into finding a solution to prevent water from soaking the newspapers in small boxes under the Mailbox. – **POA Board**

The mail delivery issues, delivery to wrong address and late delivery, were discussed. A new contract for delivery is scheduled for March and the Postmaster is planning to address the issues.
